Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

I can't believe it's been a year since I was installed as your pastor. So I thought I'd reminisce a little.

Shortly after I was installed, Lent began but was cut short by the Coronavirus (COVID-19). Though services were canceled, I still prepared and preached a sermon that was recorded for the website. Then Karen Torbeck asked if we could do the service on Facebook Live. Of course, we can. After a while, some began to attend while the recording was made, and then we celebrated the Sacrament. We missed the rest of the Lenten season, along with Holy Week (Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, and Good Friday), and, of course, Easter. It was very strange, to say the least.

Once we resumed in-person services (with due precautions), the Facebook services ended. After all, the Church gathers to hear God's Word and receive His gifts. It truly is not the same on the internet. Something vital is missing – being with fellow Christians and communing with them and our Lord.

Things seemed like they were getting somewhat back to normal, though we still take temperatures, wear masks, sit a bit apart, and avoid physical contact as much as possible. We've resumed Sunday School and Adult Bible Class. We celebrated Christmas, including the Children's program. Through it all God has richly blessed us.

Even with all that, something is still missing. Not everyone is back. Some were, and maybe still are, concerned about catching the virus, or passing it on to others, or because they were quarantined because they had been exposed to someone who had it, or had contracted it themselves. Still, God is gracious and His gifts continue to be given. So we pray that with the number of new cases going down, a vaccination available, and the weather starting to warm up a little, everyone would soon join us again to celebrate as God's people all together.

Then, on Wednesday, February 10, Kathy and I were in an accident which left us in an upside down car and sitting in icy water. By the grace and mercy of God, someone found us and

called for help. The responders did a wonderful job. We are forever grateful to the first responders from St. Peter, Brownstown, and St. Elmo. They were God's means for our rescue.

We thank God that we were not seriously hurt or worse. We also learned that it's hard not to have a cell phone. Not only for the convenience, but also because of the contact information we have in them. And, of course, with so many people using text messaging as their primary form of communication, we, or at least, I felt a bit disconnected.

Praise God, the cell phone has been replaced, along with most of the contact info. Then, of course, we needed to replace my car. And God provided for that need too – with a 1999 Olds 88. It's the first time we've had a car that was old enough to legally drink alcohol.

Now, the night of the accident, I couldn't sleep. So I got up, went downstairs, and started reading the Psalms. When I read Psalm 4, I thought how appropriate it was for that very time.

Thank God for His Word and His promises. And those promises are for you too. I encourage you to read God's Word each day, and especially the Psalms. What a treasure they are! To help you with that, I prepare Congregation at Prayer each week. Copies are available on the table in the narthex.

As we continue in this Lenten season and look forward to celebrating Easter, God be with us and bless us as we repent of our sins, trust in Jesus and all that He has done, and continues to do, for us. To Christ alone be all the glory, forever and ever, amen.
